July 13, 2023 Work Session 7:00 PM

The Work Session of Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor Grova with a flag salute. This meeting was duly advertised in accordance with the Open Public meetings law, PL 1975, Chapter 231.

Members Present: Mayor Grova, Mr. Miller, Mr. Corwonski, Mrs. Pierce, Mr. Linton and Mrs. Marandino. Absent: Mr. Carrow. Also present was Solicitor, John Moustakas and Engineer, Wayne Johnson.

Mayor Grova began the meeting with the review of the agenda:

- Resolutions NO.58-23, NO. 59-23, NO. 60-23, NO. 61-23 and NO. 62-23 request the
  Division of Local Government Services to approve revenue items to be added to our
  current General Budget. Resolution NO.62-23 are monies being added to the budget
  from donations from certain businesses in town for the Shade Tree Commission. There
  are restrictions and guidelines on the use of the monies.
- Resolution 67-23 will be added to tonight's agenda. Resolution NO. 67-23 A
  RESOLUITON APPROVING THE CONSTRUTION OF AN INDIVIDUAL SUBSURFACE
  DISPOSAL SYSTEM CLOSER TO THE BOROUGH'S RIGHT OF WAY THAN CODE
  ALLOWS. Mr. Johnson advised that the system will not be located closer than ten feet
  from the Borough's water main and it is to be located two feet off of the ROW line of
  South East Boulevard and thirteen feet from the water main on the Boulevard.
- Ordinance 2023-10 will be tabled and an executive session will be held this evening.
- There will be an introduction of the flood plan ordinance and a public hearing will be held August 10.
- Resolution No. 63-23 is a second round request to the DOT of funding for Sandy Drive in order to complete the reconstruction.

Mrs. Marandino advised that the Recreation/Special Events Committee would like council approval to hold fund raisers on the following dates:

- Serene Custard Fundraiser- Thursday August 3 from 5-9PM.
- Community Clean Up Day October 1 from 8 AM, plant mums, general clean up in advance of Newfield Day.

Mr. Miller reported that the roof project was completed along with a ten-year warranty on the roof.

Mrs. Pierce made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Mrs. Marandino seconded the motion. AIF. Meeting was adjourned at 7:20 PM.
