

Resolution NO. 3-26
A RESOLUTION CONTRACTING FOR LEGAL SERVICES FOR
THE BOROUGH OF NEWFIELD

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Newfield hereby appoints John Moustakas, Esquire of the firm of Wade, Long, Wood & Long, LLC 1250 Chews Landing Road, Laurel Springs, NJ 08021 for a one year term commencing January 1, 2026 and continuing through December 31, 2026

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "professional services" without competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the aforementioned exemption for competitive bidding, the Borough Council requested qualifications and proposals for said position and has awarded this contract under a "fair and open process" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 et seq. and Borough of Newfield Ordinance 2005-11 adopted December 13, 2005 that requires public advertising for contracts for "Professional Services"; and

WHEREAS, proposals were requested for and publicly advertised on December 3, 2025 and received on January 6, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the above-named appointee is a practitioner of a recognized profession and is so licensed or certified in the State of New Jersey; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Newfield, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the attached written contract for legal services be and is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this contract is made subject to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 et seq., N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute any contract or further documentation required to effectuate said appointment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Borough of Newfield as required by law, within ten (10) days of passage of this Resolution and a copy of said contract shall be maintained in the Office of the Borough Clerk and available for public inspection during regular business hours.




