A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PARTICIPATION IN THE FRANKLIN/ELK MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE CONSORTIUM

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth, and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Newfield has reviewed the goals and objectives of the Franklin/Elk Municipal Alliance and has indicated its desire to participate as a member of the Alliance Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Newfield has formally expressed its intent to join the Franklin/Elk Municipal Alliance Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Newfield recognizes the value of collaborative substance use prevention efforts and has expressed its intent to join the Franklin/Elk Municipal

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Borough of Newfield, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey hereby recognize:



2. The Borough Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the Borough of Newfield Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year 2026 in the amount of:

IN-KIND	\$1,500.00

3. The Borough Council acknowledges the terms and conditions for administering the Municipal Alliance Grant, including the administrative compliance and audit requirements.




