

Regular Meeting Minutes
December 11, 2025
7:00 PM

Mayor Grova called the meeting to order with a flag salute. This meeting was duly advertised in accordance with the Open Public meetings Law, PL 1975, Chapter 231.

Call of the Roll: Mayor Grova, Mr. Carrow, Mr. Corwonski, Mr. Curcio. Mr. Miller. Absent: Miss Renzi. Also present was Solicitor Moustakas and Mr. Wayne Johnson, Engineer.

Public Safety Chair- Mayor Grova reported the statistics for the police and fire for the month of November. The Sergeant that was present at the meeting advised that the department will be conducting DWI patrols during the holiday season.

Finance Chair- Mr. Carrow reported that he met with the Landis Sewerage Authority Personnel regarding connecting the downtown district to their facility. They requested some information before they could discuss costs, which we will provide to them. They would like to know the current usage of the businesses and we will consider the feasibility of grant monies for this project.

Mr. Carrow made a motion to authorize the clerk to advertise for a new Public Works Supervisor. Mr. Corwonski seconded the motion. All in favor.

Grants/Economic Development- Mrs. Engle thanked everyone that made Santa coming to town a great success. Mrs. Engle thanked the Fire Department and Special Events Committee for a great job.

Water- Mr. Curcio had no report.

License & Inspection/Health & Welfare – Mr. Miller reported that 14 permits were issued for a total of \$3185. For the month of November.

Recycling and Trash/ Buildings, Grounds, Roads Chair- Mr. Corwonski advised that December 15 is the last day to collect leaves and limbs curb side for 2025. The recycling collection will be held on December 29 due to the holiday. Mr. Corwonski commended Mr. Carrow for his work in the park with the Shade tree Commission.

Solicitor's Report - Solicitor Moustakas reported that the deed consolidation for 2 and 4 North West boulevard was prepared and ready

Engineer's Report – Mr. Johnson reported that the final change order was approved for Rena and Franklin Streets and he is working on a final close out information submission to NJDOT on Franklin Street. Rena Street close out will commence once final payment is made to South State as recommended in the Project final payment letter from Mr. Johnson.

The NJDEP is requesting a drainage survey to be submitted by the end of the year. The drainage control plan will be submitted by December 31, 2025 as required by NJDEP. Well #5 water test results were within the thresholds for discharge. Mr. Johnson advised he will submit a plan for the backwash discharge to the onsite basin as part of the application in progress by NJ Future.

Public Participation - Mr. Carrow made a motion to open the meeting to the public and Mr. Corwonski seconded the motion. No one in the public addressed council. Mr. Curcio made a motion to close the public portion of the meeting and Mrs. Engle seconded the motion. All in favor.

Mr. Carrow made a motion to approve the Minutes from: November 13, 2025 Work Session, Regular Meeting and Tax Collectors Report. Mrs. Engle seconded the motion. Roll call vote: unanimous. Motion carried.

Mr. Carow advised that Mr. Papiano is interested in the property on Gorgo Lane to expand their business. Council agreed to take it under advisement.
