

**Work Session Meeting Minutes
February 12, 2026
6:30 PM**

Due to Mayor Grova's absence, Council President, Michael Carrow called the meeting to order with a flag salute. This meeting was duly advertised in accordance with the Open Public meetings Law, PL 1975, Chapter 231.

Call of the Roll: Mr. Carrow, Mr. Corwonski, Miss Renzi, Mrs. Engle, and Mr. Miller. Absent: Mayor Grova and Mr. Curcio. Also present was Solicitor Moustakas and Engineer, Wayne Johnson.

Council President Carrow reviewed the agenda and noted that we will be adding Ordinance 2026-3 which is the amendment to the salary range ordinance. The ordinance designates the salary ranges for the employee's salaries.

- The dog and cat census is on the agenda
- There will be a public hearing on the telecom easement
- There will be a closed session to discuss personnel and contract negotiations.
- The Special Events Committee added two dates to the agenda, the yard sale to be held May 2 and 3 and Movies in the Park for August 7 with a rain date of August 8.
- Introduction of ordinance 2026-2 for fire department turn out gear. They are also working on a FEMA grant.

Mr. Johnsen reported on the \$35,000 leaf compost grant from the DEP and noted that they are requiring a new topo and survey of the property. DEP issued new storm water regulations on which we have 12 months to obtain County approval.

Mr. Nicholson reported that we can now drain the tank at the well, but it will need to be metered and tested. The Borough must continue to apply for a permanent permit to the DEP.
